All financial conditions to the JJEU and JJFA must be paid before the draw. The country will not participate at the draw if this is not respected.

### Eligibility

Ju-Jitsuka in class aspirants (U 18 - year of birth 93/94/95)  
Ju-Jitsuka in class juniors (U 21 - year of birth 90/91/92)

Two fighters/couples per category from each JJEU member state. All competitors must have a legal passport and sports passport of their respective nation! Medical certificate is needed, not older than 12 month, certifying the fitness for competition. Competitors that will reach the proper age in the present year (from 1.1 to 31.12.) have the right of participation in designate category (valid for fighting and duo system).

WADA anti doping rules will be enforced. If there are any medical exceptions which could cause problem at potential anti doping test, the national federation of the competitor is obligated to have medical certificate about medical exception. This information must be provided to organiser before the event will start.

**Combat rules:** According to combat rules of JJIF

**Categories:** Fighting U 18 male: -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, +81kg  
U 18 female: -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg  
U 21 male: -56kg, -62kg, -69kg, -77kg, -85kg, -94kg, +94kg  
U 21 female: -49kg, -55kg, -62kg, -70 kg, +70kg

Duo U 18: men, women, mixed  
U 21: men, women, mixed

## Body protection in fighting

Soft hand and foot protections in proper colour; mouthpiece and jockstrap are required, and chest protectors for female competitors in fighting system are strongly recommended.

## Referees

Each country should provide minimum 1 referee for up to 4 participants, 2 for up to 9 participants, and 3 for 10 participants and more. EUR 400,00 fees will be requested by JJEU for not having the right number of referees.

Attention: only the referees qualified from the JJEU/JJIF Referee Committee may participate as referees at Championship. The information about qualified referees will be sent out by Referee Committee. For more details see [http://www.jjif\\_referees.com](http://www.jjif_referees.com) and [www.jjif.info](http://www.jjif.info). Neither the organising committee nor the JJEU/JJIF will be responsible for not respecting this obligation. However, if there won't be enough referees for the competition to take place in good conditions, JJEU may decide to complement the pool of referees with national referees of the organizing federation – is decided by JJEU Referee Committee.

## Registration

To get an overview about participation we strongly recommend to send us a pre-registration until March 20.

After April 20 all participants are obliged to pay what they have booked.
